- (1) Log in to the registration system at <https://tocfl.edu.tw/OS/>.

- (2) Upload a headshot on the “Personal Information” page.
- (3) Wait for the headshot approval (within two working days).
- (4) After approval, complete the registration process.
- (5) Payment must be made within three days after the completion of registration.
- (6) Email proof of payment to teco.education@gmail.com, including name, contact number, test venue, and test level.
- (7) A registration confirmation email will be sent to each candidate.
